

Internships in Singapore

The University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (UIUC) seeks top students with experience in **computer vision, image processing, and/or computer-human interaction** for internships at its **Advanced Digital Sciences Center (ADSC)** in Singapore. We offer various projects involving software development supporting exciting research in these areas (see www.adsc.com.sg for an overview).

Funding is available for 3-6 months through the Singapore International Pre-Graduate Award (SIPGA) from A*STAR (see www.a-star.edu.sg for more information on SIPGA). This scholarship is available to international students in science and engineering related disciplines who are undergraduates (third year onwards) or pursuing a Masters degree. An additional allowance will be provided by ADSC.
